Frequently Asked Questions for Finalist Project Teams

Updated on October 8, 2018

What information can you provide on finalist project teams?

Of the 23 project teams that submitted concept proposals, 10 were selected as finalists and invited to submit full proposals. Additional details about applicant host institutions and project titles will be made available after awardees have been determined and announced.

For my full proposal, can I change the title and proposed budget from my concept proposal?

Yes, your proposal title can be changed. Your proposed budget can also be changed as long as it does not exceed \$3.5 million.

For my full proposal, can I change the host institution from my concept proposal?

No, your proposal's host institution cannot be changed.

For my full proposal, can I include additional individuals (e.g., co-PIs) and organizations that were not included in my concept proposal?

Yes, we encourage project teams to include additional partners to strengthen their proposals. For information on individuals and organizations interested in research partnerships, please check the CIAPM website: <http://www.ciapm.org/contacts-research-partners>.

For my full proposal, should I include any information related to the common data-sharing platform specified in the RFP?

No, there is no need to address this item in the RFP, which states that "An additional \$1.5 to \$2 million will be available for awarded project teams to examine and potentially select and use a common data-sharing platform." The process for examining and potentially selecting and using a common data-sharing platform will be separate and subsequent to the selection of awardees.
