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**2017 INCREASE: Department of Fish and Wildlife
CEQA Document Filing Fees**

On September 29, 2006 Senate Bill 1535 was passed increasing the amounts of filing fees collected by the Department of Fish and Wildlife and requires the fees be adjusted annually pursuant to Fish and Game Code Section 713. The annual fee adjustments are based on changes in the Implicit Price Deflator for State and Local Government Purchases of Goods and Services, as published by the U.S. Department of Commerce.

The table below contains the CEQA filing fees for 2016, and the adjusted fees that will become effective on January 1, 2017.

The Fish and Wildlife filing fees will increase as follows:
