Senate Bill 246 (Wieckowski, 2015)

- Purpose
 - Coordinate state, local, and regional activities on climate adaptation with a focus on local implementation
- Cross-cutting objectives
 - Advance equity and environmental justice
 - Support an integrated approach to climate change (adaptation and mitigation)
