<a href="#">SB 246</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Establish the Integrated Climate Adaptation and Resiliency Program to “coordinate regional and local efforts with State climate adaptation strategies,” including, at a minimum:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Developing tools and guidance</li> <li>Promoting and coordinating state agency support for local and regional efforts</li> <li>Informing state-led programs to better reflect the goals, efforts, and challenges faced by local and regional agencies</li> <li>Coordinate with CalOES on update to Adaptation Planning Guide</li> <li>Create Technical Advisory Council and Clearinghouse to support the goals of ICARP</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	OPR

		<a href="#">AB 2800</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Requires State agencies to consider climate change in all stages of infrastructure investment (planning, designing, building, operating, maintaining, and investing)</li> </ul>	CNRA
