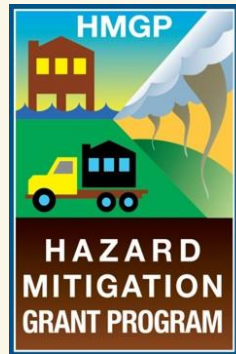

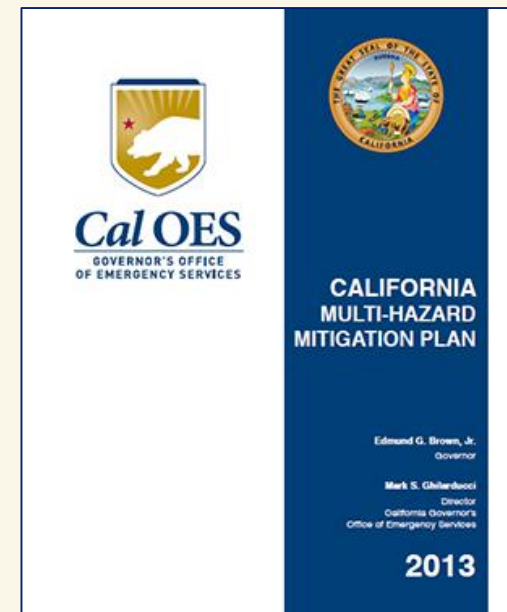
# Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000

Requires state, local, and tribal governments to have a FEMA approved hazard mitigation plan (HMP) in order to establish eligibility for FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) funding programs.



# State Hazard Mitigation Plan (SHMP)

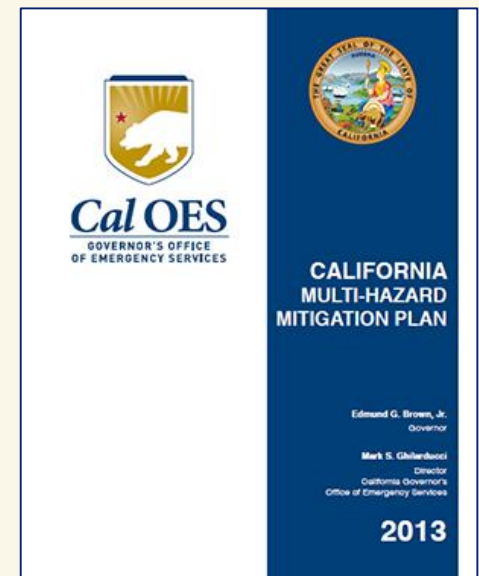
- Sets State mitigation priorities
- Provides the foundation for strategies that should be considered in the Local Mitigation Plans (LHMPs)
- Outlines actions to be implemented upon adoption



# State Hazard Mitigation Plan (SHMP)

**Approval of the SHMP makes the State eligible to apply for disaster funding including:**

- Public Assistance Categories C-G
- Fire Management Assistance Grants
- Hazard Mitigation Assistance
- Hazard Mitigation Grant Program
- Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program
- Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program



# Elements of a Local Mitigation Plan

- Planning Process
  - Identification of Natural Hazards
  - Vulnerability Assessment
  - Assessment of Mitigation Capabilities
  - Strategies to Reduce Risk
  - Implementation Information
- 
- *Tribal Mitigation Plans include the same elements but are reviewed by FEMA*
