What is Site Check?

- A free and public mapping tool that helps users quickly find parcels where housing projects may qualify for streamlining and exemptions under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
- Launched July 2023



What is Site Check?

• Intended to help accelerate the production of housing by facilitating planning decisions and clarifying where existing streamlining options under CEQA may apply



What is Site Check? (Cont.)

- Funded by California Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) as part of the technical assistance for SB 2, the Building Homes and Jobs Act
- Partnered with the Conservation Biology Institute (CBI) to develop the tool



How to use this tool

Recommended as the "<u>first step</u>" in determining how CEQA may apply to a housing project



How to use this tool

- Recommended as the "<u>first step</u>" in determining how CEQA may apply to a housing project
 - Reminder: The tool <u>CANNOT</u> be used to determine that a project is exempt from CEQA. But we hope it can provide a helpful starting point and will make users more familiar with the various provisions that have been created to accelerate housing production in California.

Data Updates

- Transit layers
- Earthquake-related layers
- Specific Plan layer
 - From September to October 2023, jurisdictions were asked to participate in a voluntary online survey to confirm existing specific plans and, if available, provide the latest geospatial boundary data for each specific plan under their purview.



New Datasets

- Building footprints
- Census Blocks
- OPR Land Use Categories



OPR Land Use Categories

- OPR staff collected and interpreted zoning code from public sources to categorize parcels statewide into thirteen general land use categories for visualization purposes
- Zoning code locally assigned is available per parcel
- Available on <u>California's State Geoportal here</u>
