



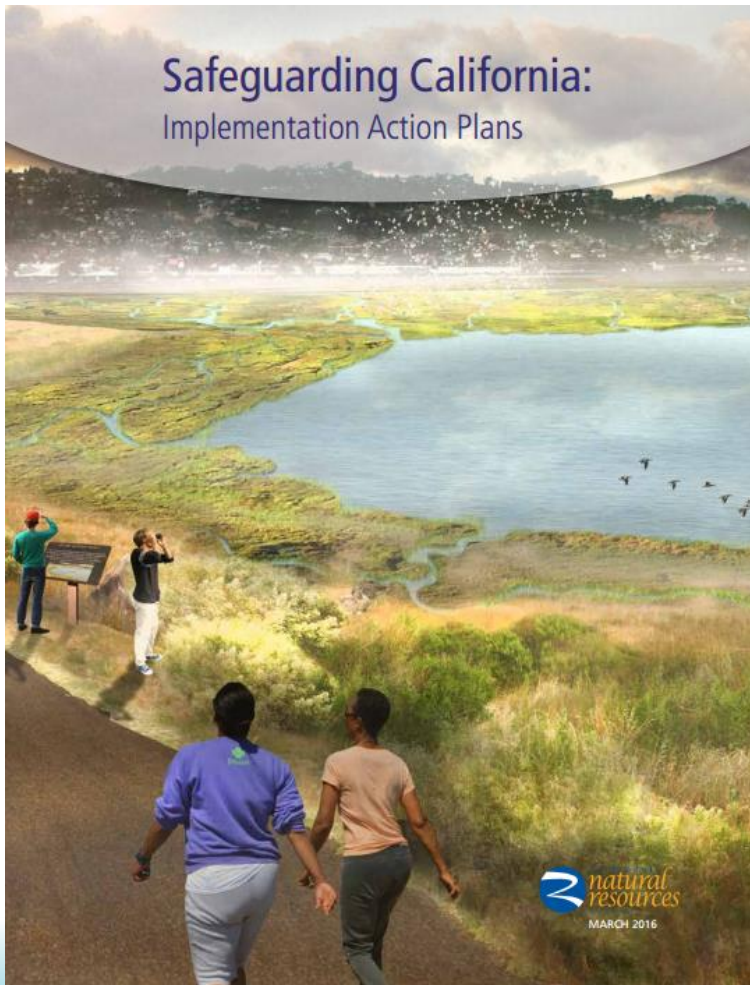

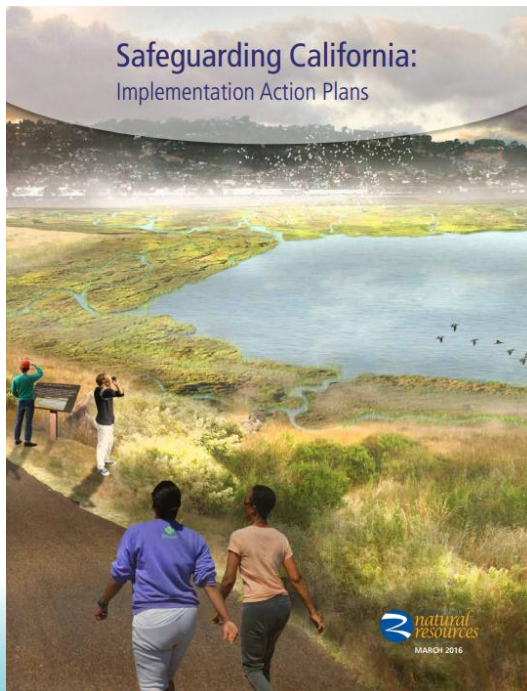

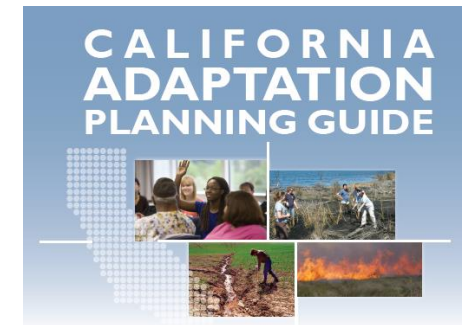
Translating plans into actions
